### To determine a NBHD (neighborhood code):

The <b>1st digit</b> is the town: “C” Clarendon Hills
<b>The 2nd digit</b> is the land location: North is north of Ogden Avenue., Central is from Ogden Avenue to RR tracks, South is from RR tracks to 55 <sup>th</sup> Street.
The <b>3rd digit</b> is the age group, which is based on the ages of all additions. Garages and porches do not affect the age of the house. Full 2 <sup>nd</sup> story additions or a 100% increase in square footage, use the age of the additions. If less than 100%, average years. If less than 25%, use original year built. <b>To be used as a guideline only!</b>
The <b>4th digit</b> is Story Height: The story height having the most SF is listed first, the next most SF is listed next and so forth.
