VIOLATION

Brush Pickup Program Non-Compliance Notice

Will Not Be Picked Up

No rakings, sweepings, roots, rocks, lumber, logs, thorny branches, stumps, grass clippings, flowers, weeds, plants, leaves, or anything in bags or other containers. No Exceptions!

Definition of Brush: branches from bushes, shrubs, and trees

Non-Compliance

Upon receipt of this non-compliance notice, the homeowner shall remove all items designated in the notice from the parkway (no later than the first Monday following the date of the non-compliance notice). Disposal of such items will be the homeowner's responsibility.

Guidelines

Brush is to be placed on the parkway no earlier than than the day before the pickup is scheduled to start in each area, and no later than 7:30 a.m. on the date pickup begins. All brush must be cut in lengths under 6' with pieces no larger than 3" in diameter. All brush must be securely bundled with string or twine and each bundle shall not exceed 25 pounds in weight. The use of wire is not acceptable to tie bundles. Items which do not conform to these guidelines will not be picked up by the Township and it will be the sole responsibility of the homeowner to dispose of them.
