## RTA REDUCED FARE PROGRAM

The RTA Reduced Fare permit allows older adults, ages 65 or over, qualified people with disabilities, and Medicare recipients to ride all RTA fixed-route services at a reduced fare.

These fixed-route services include CTA buses and trains, Metra trains, and Pace buses in the six-county region of Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry, and Will.

Downers Grove Township can assist you in applying for this program.

Helping income-eligible households with their natural gas, propane and/or electric bils, as well as assistance for inoperable furnaces.

$>$ The program will begin taking applications on October 2, 2023, for households with a senior, an individual with a disability, and children younger than six years old. Applications will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis through August 15, 2024.
> On Wednesday, Nov. 1, households that are disconnected from their utilities, have a disconnection notice, or have less than $25 \%$ in their propane tank can start applying for assistance. All other income-eligible households can start applying Dec. 1.

Downers Grove Township Boundaries Downers Grove Township is the largest township in DuPage County and covers the following areas: east to County Line Rd., west to Woodward Ave., north to 39th Street and south to the I\&M Canal. Located in the southeast corner of DuPage County, the Township's jurisdiction includes the communities of Burr Ridge, Clarendon Hills, Hinsdale, Darien, Downers Grove, Lemont, Westmont, Willowbrook and Woodridge.

## Dial-A-Ride

Dial-A-Ride is a curb-to-curb shared ride service for Downers Grove Township residents who are 65 and older. It is also a service for qualified persons, of any age, with disabilities. Riders with disabilities who are under 65 must have an RTA/ADA card.

The Dial-A-Ride service is provided to and from any point within the Township of Downers Grove boundaries. This includes service to Hinsdale Hospital,
 Good Samaritan Hospital, and Loyola Center for Health at Burr Ridge. Service is provided from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. The fare is $\$ 3.00$, cash, for each one-way ride. Please call 630-719-6670 to make an appointment.
